Ecology Site and Animal Preserve

Only Town of Brookhaven residents with reservations and proof of residency will be permitted to enter the Animal Preserve. Visitors will be required to wear masks at all times. Visitors must respect directional signs and social distancing guidelines, maintaining a distance of at least six feet from other guests at all times.

Absolutely no touching of animals is permitted; the feed machines remain closed at this time. Residents who are not feeling well, are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19, must reschedule their visit for another day.

The Information Center and Greenhouses will not be open; access to bathrooms will be available. The Animal Preserve will be open from the Main Entrance through the Eagle exhibit. The average time needed to view all of the animals is approximately 30 to 45 minutes. Animals available for viewing at this time include:
